

Woolworths recalls Woolworths Fresh Milk 'Lite' 2L

- Recall applies to products with a Use by Date of 6 December 2009
- Recall applies to all stores in VIC and Albury, Corowa, Lavington and Moama stores in NSW

Thursday 26 November 2009: Woolworths and National Foods have issued an immediate recall of Woolworths Fresh Milk Lite 2L sold in some Woolworths stores due to a product safety issue.

Routine testing has detected possible microbiological contamination and the product is being recalled as a precautionary measure.

The recall affects Woolworths Fresh Milk Lite 2L with a Use by Date of 6 December 2009 sold in all stores in Victoria. The recall also applies to Albury, Corowa, Lavington and Moama stores in NSW

The recall applies to Woolworths and Safeway outlets in these areas. The recall also applies to Caltex Woolworths/Safeway Petrol outlets in Victoria.

This recall only applies to products with the nominated size and Use by Date. No other Woolworths products (including other milk products) are affected by this product recall.

Consumers who have purchased the affected products should not consume the product and are advised to return the product to their nearest Woolworths or Safeway Supermarket for a full refund.

All potentially affected products have already been identified and removed from sale.

Woolworths and National Foods apologise to its customers for any inconvenience caused by this recall.
